

Town of Wappinger Recycling Center Regulations

Dear Residents,

Please be advised the Town of Wappinger Recycle Center is open to all Town Residents, including the residents who reside in the Village of Wappinger Falls.

The Recycle Center is managed by the Superintendent of Highways Vincent Bettina and the removal of the materials is by contract with Royal Carting which is authorized by the Town Board. The Town Highway Office is 845.297.9451.

All residents are required to purchase a Recycle Center Sticker at the Town Clerks Office located at 20 Middlebush Road which is open between the hours of 8:30 am til 4:00 pm Monday thru Friday. All purchased stickers MUST be adhered to the resident's vehicle to gain entrance to the Recycle Center. The Town Clerks office is 845.297.5771

The Recycle center offers recycled mulch for our residents use and also accepts bulk items as set forth in Recycling Center Guidelines. The Town no longer provides curb side Bulk pick up.

In order to provide safe, dependable, economical and courteous service we have provided a series of questions and answers that you may find helpful in regards to your use of the Recycle Center.

Q. Who is eligible to receive a Recycle Center Permit?

A. Only a current resident of the Town of Wappinger may use the Center. Being a resident requires that you actually reside at the location in the Town of Wappinger and also includes the Village of Wappingers residents. Being an absentee property owner does not make a person a resident or eligible to use the facility.

Q. What type of residency is required to obtain a recycle permit?

A. The required proof of residence and proof of vehicle ownership are set by the Town Board. A Driver's license with vehicle registration are the only forms that will be accepted as proof of residency. Registration and license information must match and the registration must be in the applicants' name. (Exceptions are only for family members or spouses who reside at the same residence.)

Q. What if my vehicle is registered in my Company's name? Is that sufficient?

A. No. You are required to provide proof from your employer indicating the use of the vehicle is a benefit offered thru your employment. You may also use the vehicle if you are the sole owner and the address of the Company matches your registration and residence.

Q. I just moved to the Town and do not have a current license or registration.

A. You must be able to show at least a Town tax bill, utility bill, and or provide a corrected Driver's license and registration indicating you are a new resident of the Town in order to receive a Recycle permit.

Q. How do I receive a Recycle Center Permit?

A. The Town Clerks Office is responsible for collecting the necessary information and issuance of the Recycle Permit. The recycle permit sticker must be adhered to the vehicle to allow entrance to the facility.

Q. My family members have several vehicles can I use the permit with any of them?

A. No. The permit is issued to the owner of no more than two vehicles. Each additional vehicle will require an additional permit, however there is no limit to the number of permits a resident can have provided they can provide the necessary identification.

Q. My vehicle is not large enough to transport the items that I need to dispose of, is it possible to use another vehicle?

A. You may purchase a ONE DAY PASS if you possess a valid recycle permit.

Q. What types of items can be disposed of at the Recycle Center?

A. The Recycle Center DOES NOT ACCEPT CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS and an itemized list of acceptable and not acceptable items is also available at the Town Clerks Office.

Q. I have brush and branches to dispose of and is there a limit to the size that can be accepted at the Recycle Center?

A. Branches, trees or stumps exceeding ten (10") inches in diameter are not accepted.

Q Does the Recycle Center accept household trash?

A. Yes. We accept plastics and normal food based trash.

Q. Are there any discounts for senior citizens?

A. Yes. Seniors must be sixty (60) years of age to qualify for discount.

Q My parents are elderly or handicapped and cannot make it to the Clerk's office to pick up the required trash tickets can we pick them up for them?

A. You will have to write a letter to the Town Board via the Town Clerk requesting an approval and verifying that your parents meet the Town criteria for a recycle permit. (Should the approval be granted it will be kept on file.)

Q. What types of vehicles can be used and is there a limit to the size of the vehicle to transport the items to the Recycle Center?

A. Yes. Only passenger vehicles, pickup trucks and double axel trailers are permitted and must be attached to the vehicle with a valid permit. Box trucks, vans, rack trucks and dump trucks are prohibited from entering the facility.

Senior Citizens / Single Axle	\$30.00
Double Axle	\$25.00
Single day Permit (For any of the above)	\$ 15.00
Residential Trash per bag	\$ 4.00 per ticket (\$20.00 per book of 5 tickets)
Seniors	\$ 2.00 per ticket (\$10.00 per book of 5 tickets)
Freon Purge Stickers (1 per item)	\$ 15.00
Computer monitors (1 per item)	\$ 10.00
Leaves and or Brush permit	Requires annual permit or single day
